The happy occasion takes place on Sunday, November 6, 2011, 3 p.m. in the parish hall. Tea and cookies will be served. A brief introduction to the book will begin at 3:15, and you are invited to walk through the church to enjoy the windows. The book's authors and photographer will be on hand to answer questions. (The parish hall is located at Monument and North Tejon Street with the entrance on Monument Street.)

The Windows of Grace and St. Stephen's Episcopal Church is a hard-bound 9"x12", 112 page volume which features colored photographs of each of the parish's windows, with accompanying explanatory texts. Attention is given to persons memorialized in each window along with the donor and artist. The book includes an introduction by our rector, The Reverend Stephen Zimmerman, a brief history of the parish, a preface, biographies of the artists, a listing of the rectors dating from 1873 to the present, a bibliography of sources, and a floor plan to guide the visitor.

Books may be purchased at the celebration for \$50 + \$3.70 tax, by check, cash, or money order. Orders received through the mail will add an additional \$8 per book for shipping and handling (www.graceststephensepiscopal.org)
