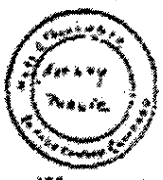

STATE OF COLORADO)
COUNTY OF EL PASO) ss.
I, Alexander G. Magruder, do solemnly swear that
at a mass meeting of the members of The Protestant
Episcopal Church in the United States of America, in
the City of Colorado Springs, in the Diocese and State
of Colorado, duly convened according to the usages and

customs of said Church, held at Grace Church in the City of Colorado Springs on the 19th
day of December, A.D. 1923, the following persons were elected as the Wardens and Vestry-
men of a parish in the Diocese of Colorado to be known and designated as Grace Church and
St Stephen's, namely:

- Harry Jackson Senior Warden,
- Alexander G. Magruder Junior Warden,
- George A. Fowler
- Lee W. Beresford
- Thomas H. Powers
- Ernest S. Peley
- Charles L. Tull
- George L. Robinson

with powers and duties similar to the powers and duties of Trustees, according to the rules and usages of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America and the following was adopted as the Corporate name of said parish:

GRACE CHURCH AND ST. STEPHEN'S

And that at said meeting the members of said society did, by resolution, adopt certain other articles which they desire to exist as a part of their charter, to-wit:

Clause 1. The objects and purposes for which said parish is incorporated are to administer the temporalities of The Protestant Episcopal Church in the parish and to carry on and conduct religious, educational and benevolent institutions and works; to acquire by lease, purchase, gift or otherwise, hold, use and enjoy, let, sell, mortgage, convey or otherwise dispose of, any and all real estate and personal property, as may be determined by said corporation to be beneficial or useful in carrying out said purposes, and particularly, to acquire, hold, use and enjoy all of the property now held for the members of said Church in the City of Colorado Springs, in the County of El Paso and State of Colorado, whether the title to the same be held by that parish now known as Grace Church and Parish, in the City of Colorado Springs, or by that parish now known as St. Stephen's Church and Parish in the City of Colorado Springs or by any other person or persons or corporations acting, for or on behalf of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the City of Colorado Springs; and the said corporation, acting through its said Wardens and Vestrymen, shall have power and authority to borrow money and to pledge its franchise and property, both real and personal, to secure the payment thereof and said Wardens and Vestrymen may have and exercise all the powers necessary and requisite to carry into effect the objects for which said corporation is formed.

Clause 2. The corporation hereby created does hereby expressly accept to all the provisions of the constitution and canons adopted by the General Convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America, and to all of the provisions of the constitution and canons of the Diocese of Colorado.

Clause 3. The Wardens and Vestrymen of this corporation who shall serve until the next annual meeting of the corporation shall be the following:

Alexander C. Magruder	Junior Warden.

The successors to the above mentioned Wardens and Vestrymen shall be chosen by the qualified voters of the parish at the annual meeting of the qualified voters of the parish, to be called and held in accordance with the provisions of the canons of the Diocese of Colorado.

Clause 4. The Rector of the parish hereby incorporated and known and designated as Grace Church and St. Stephen's shall be chosen in accordance with the constitution and canons of The Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America and in accordance with the constitution and canons of the Diocese of Colorado, and shall have and exercise all of the powers conferred upon a Rector by such constitutions and canons. The corporation, in accordance with the rules and usages of said Church, may elect a Co-Rector and such assistant Rectors as may be deemed necessary for the administration of the affairs of the parish.

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Clause 5. The parish hereby incorporated to be known and designated as Grace Church and St Stephen's is formed, among other things for the purpose of merging the present parishes of Grace and St Stephen's in the City of Colorado Springs, in accordance with Section 3 of Canon XII of the Canons of the Diocese of Colorado, and for the purpose of becoming their legal successor. This corporation shall have the power to take, hold and administer any and all gifts, bequests or devises which may have been made in the past or which may in the future be made to the present parishes of Grace and St Stephen's.

Clause 6. The Rector, Co-Rector, Wardens and Vestrymen may adopt necessary by-laws for the proper government of the affairs of the corporation, and shall have power to amend or repeal the same.

I further do solemnly swear that at said meeting I, the said Alexander C. Magruder, did act as chairman.
